

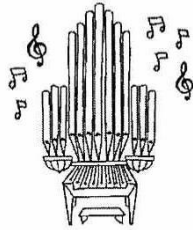

April 25 is International Organ Day

- The Organ is the King of Instruments
- The Organ is one of the oldest instruments dating back centuries

The Windsor Essex Centre of the Royal Canadian College of Organists (RCCO) is inviting anyone, especially young people, interested in the Organ to see an organ up close, learn about it, hear it, and play it.

On April 25, designated venues across Windsor and Essex County will open their doors between 10:00 and 12:00 pm. (see reserve side)

Bring a piece of music or play your favourite piece from memory (even if it is 'Chopsticks'). Learn how to make different sounds using a variety of 'organ stops', take a picture of you on the organ bench or record your organ playing debut.
